



Shop Talk

with Jon Olson

I had a former student come visit me the other day and was telling me about his truck. He had just recently put a new engine in it due to two blown head gaskets that were not addressed in a timely manner. Knowing this particular individual, it doesn't surprise me. That may sound a little mean, but as an instructor I have to keep in mind that all I can do is provide my students with the knowledge and experience to make good choices when it comes to vehicle maintenance and repairs. The application portion is up to the students. When they leave my class, it is their choice to apply the knowledge and procedures that I have taught them, or choose their own path.

This particular incident with this individual obviously did not turn out very well for him. However, more times than not I have former students telling me how they caught a potential problem well before it became a major issue.

Blown head gaskets are extremely common as the weather begins to change at the end of a winter season. If you notice a good deal of white smoke coming out of your exhaust pipe (not due to the hot exhaust on a cold day). It is a very likely indication that you have antifreeze leaking through the head gasket into the combustion chamber.

If not addressed it can cause engine failure and damage of many components.

Check Your Coolant

Visually check your coolant levels once a month. If your coolant is low each time you check, then it could indicate that you have a leak.
